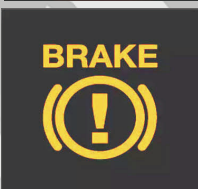
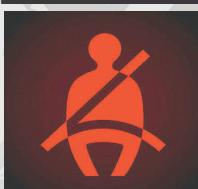




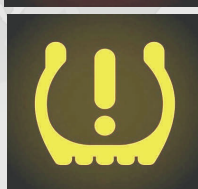

Badge Event for Senior Girl Scouts

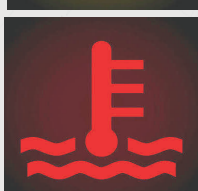

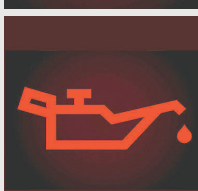


Steps

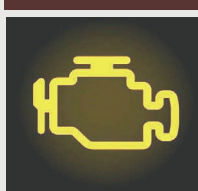
1. Get a handle on basic car maintenance

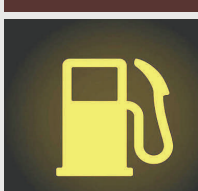


How to register:
