World Thinking Day 2018

Thinking Day was first created in 1926 at the fourth Girl Guide/Girl Scout International Conference held at Girl Scouts of the USA's Camp Edith Macy. Conference attendees decided that there should be a special day for Girl Scouts and Girl Guides from around the world to "think" of each other and give thanks and appreciation to their "sister" Girl Scouts. The delegates chose February 22 as the date for Thinking Day because it was the mutual birthday of Lord Baden-Powell, founder of the Boy Scout movement, and his wife, Olave, who served as World Chief Guide.

Since then, each year on February 22 (Cranford will participate on Friday, Feb 23rd), World Thinking Day, girls participate in activities and projects with global themes to honor their sister Girl Guides and Girl Scouts in other countries.

In 2018, WAGGS would like to IMPACT our communities with the World Thinking Day celebrations, and invite Girl Scout Troops to create an IMPACT on their communities by taking action on projects that are important to them.

The theme and activity pack will be designed to fit with the WAGGS strategy to 'Connect, Grow, Impact'. In 2016, we celebrated the meaningful connections we share as a Movement; in 2017 we Grew in our knowledge. This year is the year to take ACTION!

Troops of all ages are encouraged to participate in this Girl Scout Tradition.
